## Spencer Classroom Windows & OS X Connections: Best Practices

It is helpful to arrive to the classroom with your laptop powered down as it ensures the most stable startup.

1. Connect one of the VGA cables to the PC (use a Mini DisplayPort adapter with most smaller devices, i.e. MacBook, Surface, etc.). The cables are labeled Laptop 1 and Laptop 2.



- 2. If your presentation has audio, connect the attached 3.5mm audio cable to your computer's headphones port. *Each audio cable is attached to its corresponding VGA cable, labeled 1 or 2.*
- 3. Select the appropriate input (Laptop 1 Laptop 2).



**4.** Power on the computer. Once you've logged in, the system should be projecting your computer's display.

## **Troubleshooting Image Projection with Windows:**

• Try pressing the Windows Key () and P simultaneously on your keyboard until the display mode is set to "Duplicate." Release the keys. Your screen will flash and should be displayed on both the screen and your computer.
